Drama 3b: Let my people go!

A shorter version of the story of the plagues that could be used at the beginning of drama 4 (A day at the seaside) to shorten the series.

Characters Narrator Moses Aaron Pharaoh

Scene: Pharaoh's palace. (When used with drama 4 this can be the back of stage scene to be used later)

(Pharaoh is sitting on his couch)

Nar: So Moses and Aaron went to see Pharaoh.

(Moses and Aaron enter)

Phar: Yes? What do you want?

Moses: The God of the Hebrews and the God of my fathers says: Let my

people go

Phar: What? Let the Hebrews go? You must be joking! Who will make

bricks and build cities and pyramids for me? Sorry mate, no can do!

The Hebrews are staying.

Aaron: Well in that case Pharaoh, God will have to teach you a lesson!

Phar: Huh! Let him try. I am Pharaoh you know. The most powerful man in

the world!

Nar: So Aaron threw down his stick and it turned into a snake. Phar: Oh Oh, well err.... That is err... quite impressive.

Nar: But then one of his magicians did the same.

Phar: Oh well, now I'm not impressed at all. Sorry, the Hebrews will have to

stav.

Nar: So God sent plagues upon Egypt.
Moses: There was the plague of blood!
Aaron: All the water turned to blood!

Phar: Yuck, that's horrible.

Moses: Then god sent a plague of frogs.

Aaron: They were everywhere. In the living room, in the beds, in the larder Phar: (with hands over ears) Stop that infernal croaking! It's driving me mad!!

Aaron: Gazillions of them, and they are very crunchy when they get in your

sandwiches!

Phar: I've been bitten and it's very itchy!

Aaron: and finally a plague of death!

(All pause for 10 seconds)

Phar: Enough!! Enough!! Go!! Pack your bags and go!! I never want to see

another Hebrew ever again!!!

Nar: So Moses and the Hebrews packed their bags and travelled from all

over Egypt to begin their journey to the Promised Land. But......

Would they really be allowed to escape from Pharaoh?
