Chorus: 2 or 3 people.

Props:

Royal Cloak and Crown.

Throne.

Cushion

Bowl of grapes.

The Ark.

Nar: King Saul was still angry with David.

Saul: Grrrrr.

Nar: No, much more angry than that!!

Saul: GRRRRRRRRRRRR!!!!

Nar: So angry that he spent all his time looking for David.

(Saul walks around the Church, talking to people saying: Do you know where he is? I'm sure you're hiding him! You look like him in disguise! etc etc. Saul returns to front).

Nar: But Saul could not find David anywhere, even though at times David was right behind him!

(David sneaks up behind Saul and jumps around quietly with his tongue out, then leaves stage).

Nar: David's best friend, Jonathan, who was also Saul's son, still did his best to get Saul to leave David alone.

(Enter Jonathan)

Jon: Your Majesty! Your Majesty! Please give David another chance. He really is a nice guy!

Saul: No!

Jon: Oh please.

Saul: No!!

Jon: But won't you...

Saul: NO!!!
